**WARNING:** Chapter 2.115 of the Sacramento County Code regulates contributions to campaigns for County elective office.

Before making a contribution to my campaign, please read Chapter 2.115, and in particular sections 2.115.255, 2.115.260, 2.115.300 and 2.115.310 to determine if your contribution complies with Chapter 2.115.
